Competency 002: <i>The teacher of students with visual impairments, including those with additional disabilities, knows how to produce UEB and Nemeth Code using a braillewriter.</i>											
A. Transcribes passages into UEB.											
B. Transcribes math expressions into Nemeth Code.
